

# Taurewa

## Val's Woolly Hat

*Two woolly hats are required by each student for their trip to camp. If you get carried away and find this most therapeutic, any extra hats can be donated to the Taurewa Room.*



### One Size Fits All

### Materials:

Two (2) 50g balls Double Knitting - **100% Wool**.  
1 pair 4mm (8) knitting needles.

### Hat is knitted in Double Rib

### Abbreviations:

To be read before working:

K., knit plain; p., purl; st., stitch; tog., together; dec., decrease (by working 2 sts. tog.).

### To Knit:

With 4mm (8) needles cast on 126 sts. and work 88 rows as follows:

*1<sup>st</sup> row rib:* K. 1, p. 2, \* k. 2, p. 2; repeat from \* until 1 st. remains, k. 1.

*2<sup>nd</sup> row rib:* P.1, k. 2, \* p. 2, k. 2; repeat from \* until 1 st. remains, p. 1.

Work should now measure 27 cms from beginning.

*1<sup>st</sup> dec. row:* K. 1, \* p. 2 tog., k. 2 tog.; repeat from \* until 3 sts remain, p. 2 tog., k. 1 – 67 sts.

*2<sup>nd</sup> dec. row:* P. 1, \* p.2 tog.; repeat from \* to end - 34 sts.

*3<sup>rd</sup> dec. row:* \* K. 2 tog.; repeat from \* to end – 17 sts.

*4<sup>th</sup> dec. row:* P. 1, \* p. 2 tog.; repeat from \* to end.

Break off wool and thread through remaining 9 sts., draw up tightly and fasten off securely.  
Join seam. Fold edge back to form brim.

### Washing Instructions:

Pure wool must be **HANDWASHED IN LUKEWARM** water and line dried.

**DO NOT PUT IN THE CLOTHES DRYER!!**
